STATIC IMAGE AND POSTER DESIGN BRIEFS

Design either a:

- a) Static image inspired by a Shakespeare play, including a quote from it
- b) Poster for a Shakespeare production by your school or any theatre group Tick appropriate box on Entry Form.

The image/poster should be

- presented on A3 or A4 paper or light card
- and sent in an appropriate size folder or tube

The Static Image should reflect a play through image and words e.g. a quote. The Poster must include play and performance details.

The image must have an accompanying rationale of approximately 400 words describing:

- for a) why you have chosen the play for which you are creating the static image
- for b) a brief outline of the style in which the play is being performed
- · why you are using the reflected style in your image
- the target audience to whom you are directing the design

- Any students at secondary school, home schooled, or community groups from Year 7-13, under 20 years of age are eligible to enter
- All spelling must be accurate
- Entrants must be a Friend of SGCNZ either through their school, home school cluster or community groups, or individually

Prize winners will be announced at SGCNZ's National University of Otago Sheilah Winn Shakespeare Festival Award Ceremony at 7.00pm, Sunday 4 June 2023 at the St James Theatre in Wellington. The finalists may attend workshops at SGCNZ National UOSWSF free-of-charge on Friday 3 June in Wellington.

The winning designs will be displayed at the National Festival and will then be displayed in Shakespeare's Globe Exhibition, London for 6 weeks (Covid permitting) and in other locations in NZ.
